

Basic requirements of Illinois and Missouri Chiropractic Schools

The following courses complete the requirements for either Logan College of Chiropractic in St. Louis, Missouri, or National University of Health Sciences in Lombard, Illinois. To apply, Logan College of Chiropractic requires a minimum of 90 semester hours. National University of Health Sciences requires a baccalaureate degree. A standardized admission test is not required for chiropractic school.
